**FINAL ORDER**

**As of: 5-7-08**

7 The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services proposes to suspend  
8 Respondent's Oregon plumbing contractor's license number PB234 until such time as the  
9 Respondent shows proof to the Department that Respondent has on file with the Construction  
Contractor's Board (CCB) an active license.

10 The authority of the Director to suspend this license is OAR 918-030-0015(4).

11 The Director intends to suspend the aforementioned license because Respondent has failed to  
12 maintain an active CCB License.

13 On March 21, 2008 a Special Notice was served upon the Respondent. That Notice provided the  
14 Respondent with 15 days in which to contact the division to resolve the matter. At the time of this  
Notice, Respondent has not contacted the division and a search of the CCB database shows that the  
Respondent's CCB License remains suspended for lack of bond.

15 Based on the above, the Director intends to suspend Respondent's plumbing contractor's license  
16 until such time as the Respondent shows proof to the Department that Respondent has on file with  
the Construction Contractor's Board (CCB) an active license pursuant to OAR 918-030-0015(4).

17 This period shall commence 21 days from the date of service of this notice unless the Respondent  
18 requests a hearing pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter  
19 183. If the Respondent requests a hearing, then the suspension of the Respondent's license will be  
stayed pending resolution of the hearing.

20 Definitions relevant to this Notice are contained in ORS 447.010, ORS 455.010 and ORS 693.010.

21 **NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING**

22 You are entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act, Oregon Revised  
23 Statutes, Chapter 183. If you wish to receive a hearing you must file a written request for a hearing  
24 with the Board no later than 20 days from the date of service of this notice. If a request for hearing  
is not received within the 20-day period your right to a hearing shall be considered waived unless  
25 the failure to request a hearing was beyond your reasonable control. Requests for hearing must be  
sent to: Building Codes Division, Enforcement and Licensing Section, PO Box 14470, Salem,  
Oregon, 97309.

1 You have the right to be represented by legal counsel. ORS 183.457 provides a corporation may be  
2 represented by an authorized representative at the hearing. If you request a hearing the Board will  
3 notify you of the time and place of the hearing.

4 **NOTICE OF FINAL ORDER**

5 If you do not request a hearing within 20 days from the date of mailing of this notice or if you  
6 withdraw a hearing request or fail to appear at a scheduled hearing, the Boards may issue a Final  
7 Order by Default and revoke both your electrical contractor's licenses, your boiler/pressure vessel  
8 business license, and your plumbing license. If the Boards issue a Final Order by Default against  
9 you, it will designate the Building Codes Division's file on the matter as the record. You are  
entitled to judicial review of this order. Judicial review may be obtained by filing for review within  
80 days from the date this order was served. Judicial review is pursuant to the provisions of ORS  
183.482 to the Court of Appeals.
