

Instruction Sheet for the Grounding and Bonding Correspondence Course, part I and part II

These courses are designed to encourage the examinee to research and understand the complex issues regarding grounding and bonding of electrical system components for protection of equipment and personnel.

Reference materials:

- 1) 2008 National Electrical Code, (the blue NEC Handbook is best, but not required).

Exam scoring:

There are 80 multiple-choice questions in each of the two exam parts that cover information found in the reference materials indicated above. Each question is worth 1.25 points for a total of 100 points possible for Part I and 100 points possible for Part II.

CEU credits:

A passing grade of 75%, (60 correct answers), will result in 4 hours of Code-Related Continuing Education credits being posted to the examinee's license data. Passing Part I and Part II earns 8 hours of CEU credit.

Taking the exam:

- Download and print the answer sheet or complete the answer sheet on-line
- Be sure to include your name and license number on the answer sheet
- Fill in the letter designation for the correct answer in the appropriate numbered box
- Exam Part I is numbered from 1 through 80, Exam Part II is numbered 81 through 160
- Make sure you are using the correct answer sheet for the exam part you are taking!
- Print and mail or save the online answer sheet as a document and e-mail to the Building Codes Division.
